The Role:

The Graduate Consultant will report to a senior Communities consultant and work closely with other internal teams including our in-house planners and environmental consultants to deliver projects. They will work primarily on socio-economic assessments as part of the planning for a range of high-profile infrastructure and property developments. Other projects might include health impact assessments and social and economic strategy work.

The successful candidate will be equally at home with data analysis and technical writing. They will be able to demonstrate an ability to work with clients, understand their needs, and translate these into presentable solutions.

The Graduate Consultant will provide essential support on projects and to specific business areas. Initial assignments will typically include background research, review of planning policy, data collection and analysis and contributing to discussions in meetings.
