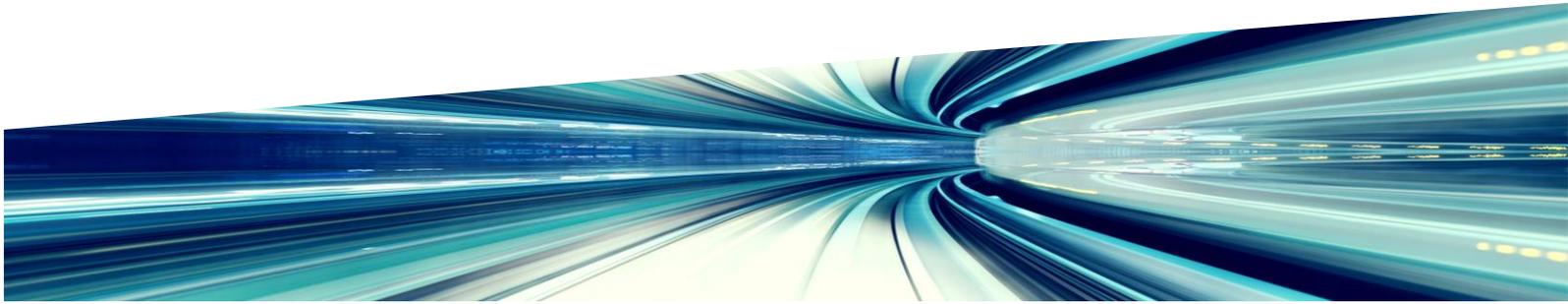

The Roles

The Senior Consultants will report to the EIA Property or Infrastructure team lead and work closely with all internal teams and potentially with the wider group of companies.

The successful candidates would be expected to have excellent project management, report writing and client liaison skills with a keen eye for detail and a positive attitude towards business development. They will lead or contribute to proposals and projects of all scales. Their role within project delivery may be as project director, project manager, framework manager and/or technical lead.

Responsibilities will include the coordination and preparation of a variety of EIA projects including the technical reviews, financial management, preparation of fee proposals, management of the review process and training / mentoring of junior members of the team.

The Candidate

We expect the successful candidates will:

- Ideally have 5+ years of client-facing consulting experience.
