The Role: -

The Senior Consultant will report to the Digital Delivery team lead and work closely with ecology and major programme teams. They will work with the rest of the Digital Delivery team to apply GIS tools and techniques, web and mobile apps, and data management workflows to create efficient ecosystems for all aspects of ecology work.

The successful candidate will also be expected to create and maintain documentation and training material and be comfortable supporting field-based workers in using the tools. They must be able to demonstrate an ability to work with internal and external clients, understanding their needs, and translate these into presentable solutions.

Responsibilities will include driving and enhancing Temple's digital offer through identifying and pursuing new opportunities and contributing to the development of strategic offers. The successful candidate will have to be comfortable applying their knowledge to new situations and developing their skills to address future challenges and the digital needs of the business.
