1.0 Temple Online Privacy Policy

1.1 Information Collected

We collect personal information from you at registration and other times (for instance, when you send us an enquiry (such as your name, email address, postal address and telephone number).

You are under no obligation to provide us with such information. However, if you choose to withhold requested information, we may not be able to respond effectively to your query or provide you with certain services.

1.2 Use of personal information

We process information collected via the Site for the purposes of:

- Conducting market consultation exercises; and

We may occasionally also send you direct mail by email, Temple products and services which may be of interest to you.
